



Description:

Stat-Pak™ Knitted Retraction Cord is used to retract sulcular tissue, protect tissues and arrest sulcular fluid seepage. Easy to control and place, knitted Stat-Pak™ Dental Retraction Cord carries more hemostatic agent to the tooth preparation and remains in-situ, even when touched by a bur or diamond.

Indication:

- Cords are placed easily with no fraying and no memory.
- Cord conforms to sulcular anatomy with gentle outward force.

Precautions:

DO NOT reuse.

Instructions for Use:

- Prepare crown as usual.
- Select a thin packer to place the cord. The interlocking loops prevent instrument from penetrating cord.
- 3. Pack cord into the sulcus, distending into the tissue. Limit to one quadrant of the mouth at a time.
- 4. Follow packing, the loops maintain a gentle, continuous, outward force against the gingival cuff, Leave 3-minutes.
- 5. Remove cord and spray with air/water rinse.
- 6. If bleeding is still persistent, repeat steps until hemostasis is achieved.
- 7. Rinse, dry, make impression
