









Indications:

Vista-Cal[™] Calcium Hydroxide paste is a 12.5pH aqueous solution containing no more than 35% calcium hydroxide. The radiopaque solution may be used in conventional endodontic treatments, pulp cappina, fracture repair or as a temporary intra-canal dressing.

Instructions for Use:

- 1. Isolate area to be treated with a rubber dam.
- Remove Vista-Cal[™] syringe and applicator tip from their packaging.
- 3. Remove syringe cap and attach tip securely to syringe. Apply as desired: only small amounts are necessary for pulp capping or canal dressing. During apexification techniques apply material apically while slowly retreating from the canal. (The use of a plugger may assist in packing the material)
- 4. Remove and dispose of tip from the syringe.
- 5. Clean and disinfect syringe between patients.
- 6. Recap syringe between uses and storage in accordance with specified storage conditions.

STORE AT ROOM TEMPERATURE

Continue rinsing. IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.



WARNING
