Endocator is an adjunctive device, it is not a diagnostic device. Regardless of Endocator results, use your clinical judgment to determine the best course of action for treatment.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAMPLE COLLECTION

- 1. Turn on the Endocator.
- 2. Aspirate canals to remove irrigants.
- Fill new syringe with approximately 1mL of sterile water, attach tip.
- 4. Rinse canals to remove trace irrigants. Leave canals and half the chamber filled with water.
- Pump tip up and down in each canal 2-3 times to agitate water facilitating sample collection.
- 6. Aspirate sample into empty syringe, taking all fluid from chamber and half of every canal. [See Figure A].

Note: Take care not to touch irrigation tip prior to sample collection.
